- Have skills and experience in working with students with special needs.

- Demonstrate initiative, flexibility and the ability to work independently.
- Demonstrate an ability and willingness to take on roles within the College and being involved in extra-curricular activities.
- Demonstrate the capacity and enthusiasm to build community in a growing Pre-K to 12 Catholic College in collaboration with staff, parents, students and Parish.

### Qualifications Required

- Certificate IV
- Accreditation to Work in a Catholic School (or working towards / be prepared to acquire)

Applicants must submit a curriculum vitae addressed to the Principal, including the names and contact numbers of three referees, which must include the current employer.

A current 'CrimTrac' 100 point Check Police Clearance must also be included. The appropriate Criminal History Record Check form is available from the Department of Education and Training website.

On appointment, successful applicants will require a current Working with Children Check. Application forms are available at certain Australia Post Outlets throughout the State. A list of participating Australia Post outlets can be found on the Australia Post website. An application for a WWC must be made in person.
