In 2019 we will have over 300 students from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 5. The College will continue to grow to reach its ultimate capacity as a K-12 College with the first intake of Year 7 students commencing in 2021.

The Salvado Catholic College community enjoys a strong relationship with the St Francis Xavier Armadale Parish and promotes engagement with families within the Salvado Catholic College community to further enhance a positive home/school partnership.

By the commencement of 2019 we will have completed our Stage Two Build which will complete the Primary section of the College, and then during 2019 works will commence on Stage Three and our Secondary section of the College. The innovatively designed buildings have a focus on collaborative, shared and flexible learning spaces that support best practice and 21st century teaching and learning approaches.

This is an outstanding opportunity for an inspiring educator to positively influence the lives of students in the Byford area and contribute to the formation of a new Catholic College community.

- Demonstrate pedagogical skills with a flexible, collaborative and student-centred approach.
- Possess a sound knowledge of the Religious Education guidelines and the Western Australian Curriculum.
- Demonstrate the ability to use assessment and continuous monitoring methods and tools to adjust the teaching/learning program and teaching practices to cater for the needs of all students.
- Display excellent classroom management and organisational skills.
- Display excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Demonstrate a high level of expertise in integrating digital technologies to enrich teaching and learning experiences.
- Demonstrate the capability to work collaboratively with other staff to promote student learning and to enhance one's own teaching instruction and the learning culture of the College.
- Demonstrate an ability to lead by taking on roles within the College and being involved in extra-curricular activities.
- Demonstrate the capacity and enthusiasm to build community in a new Catholic College in collaboration with staff, parents, parish and students.

Qualifications Required

- Accreditation to Teach Religious Education
- Relevant 4 Year Tertiary Qualifications

Applicants must submit a curriculum vitae, addressed to the Principal, including the names and contact numbers of three referees - current employer, professional colleague and Parish Priest.

Applicants must have a current registration as a teacher with the Teacher Registration Board of WA (TRBWA) to be eligible for appointment. Information is available from the TRBWA website.
